

Crochet Granny Rectangle Photo Tutorial

This is a primarily visual photo tutorial with instructions for how to make a crochet granny rectangle.

For the granny rectangle in the tutorial, I used a 4.5 mm hook and worsted weight yarn, but depending on your personal tension and the degree of drape you want for your finished project, this pattern could readily accommodate a worsted weight yarn crocheted with a hook anywhere in the range from 4.0 mm to 6.0 mm.

Materials:

Worsted weight yarn in a variety of colors

4.5 mm hook

Yarn needle to weave in ends

Scissors to trim them

To begin the photo tutorial, scroll down the next page, and happy crocheting!





With color A, chain 7



Y/O and insert hook under back ridge loop of 4th chain from hook



Complete dc and work a second dc through the same back ridge loop



Skip 2 chains, 3 dc through back ridge loop of next chain, chain 1



3 dc in same st as previous 3 dc, ch 1



3 dc in same st as previous 3 dc, two corners completed



Insert hook under both loops of chain where first dc was worked, and work 3dc, ch 1



Insert hook under both loops of chain where first dc was worked, and work 3dc, ch 1



Join with slip st to top of ch-3 dc. Fasten off and weave in ends



Join color B with slip st to ch-1 corner as shown. Chain 3 — counts as first dc



2 dc into same ch-1 space



3 dc in space between next 3 dc cluster



3 dc, chain 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, corner made



3 dc, chain 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space



3 dc in space between next 3 dc cluster



3 dc, chain 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space



3 dc in ch-1 space where first 3 dc cluster made, chain 1



Join with slip st to top of first dc, fasten off and weave in ends



Join Color C with slip st in ch-1 corner, chain 3, 2 dc in same space



3 dc in space between next 3 dc clusters, two times



3 dc, chain 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space



3 dc in space between next 3 dc cluster



3 dc, chain 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space



3 dc in space between next 3 dc clusters, two times



3 dc, chain 1, 3 dc, in next ch-1 space, 3 dc in space between 3 dc clusters



3 dc in first ch-1 space, chain 1



Join with slip st to top of ch-3, fasten off, and weave in ends
